

FAQs

Do I need my own instrument?

Yes, you will need your own instrument in order to practice and progress, however, if an instrument is not yet purchased/rented at the time of the first lesson this will not be an issue.

Do you come to students' homes?

Usually I'm not traveling to students' homes. I would make an exception if the student's house is in walking distance from my studio and set up suitable for a private lesson.

Where is the studio located?

The studio is located inside my home in the Gerrard East Area of Leslieville, Toronto.
The studio can be accessed through a separate entrance.

What are your rates?

\$30 / 30min lesson

\$40/ 45min lesson

\$50/ 1h lesson

Do you offer a free trial lesson?

While I don't offer a free trial lesson, you are welcome to meet me, see the studio and ask me any individual questions.

Do you offer group lessons?

I believe that an individual student-teacher relationship is a lot more beneficial to the student as every student learns differently and at a different pace. If enough parents express an interest in theory classes group lessons will be considered.

How often and how long do I need to practice?

Depending on a student's personal goal practicing can last anywhere from 20minutes/day to several hours/day. Key to good practicing is consistency and quality, meaning that 30minutes/day will be more efficient than a 3 hour long practice session the day before the next lesson. The quality of practicing will be addressed in the lessons.

Will there be a recital?

There will be a minimum of one recital per year in which every student will have the chance to demonstrate their progress once he/she is ready to perform.
